The Districts Water System encompasses 2.5 square miles. The infrastructure of the system is comprised of:



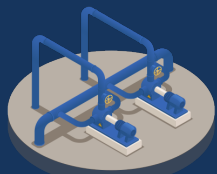

**Recycled Water Project** – The District is currently in the process of working alongside 16 customers to retrofit their existing irrigation systems.



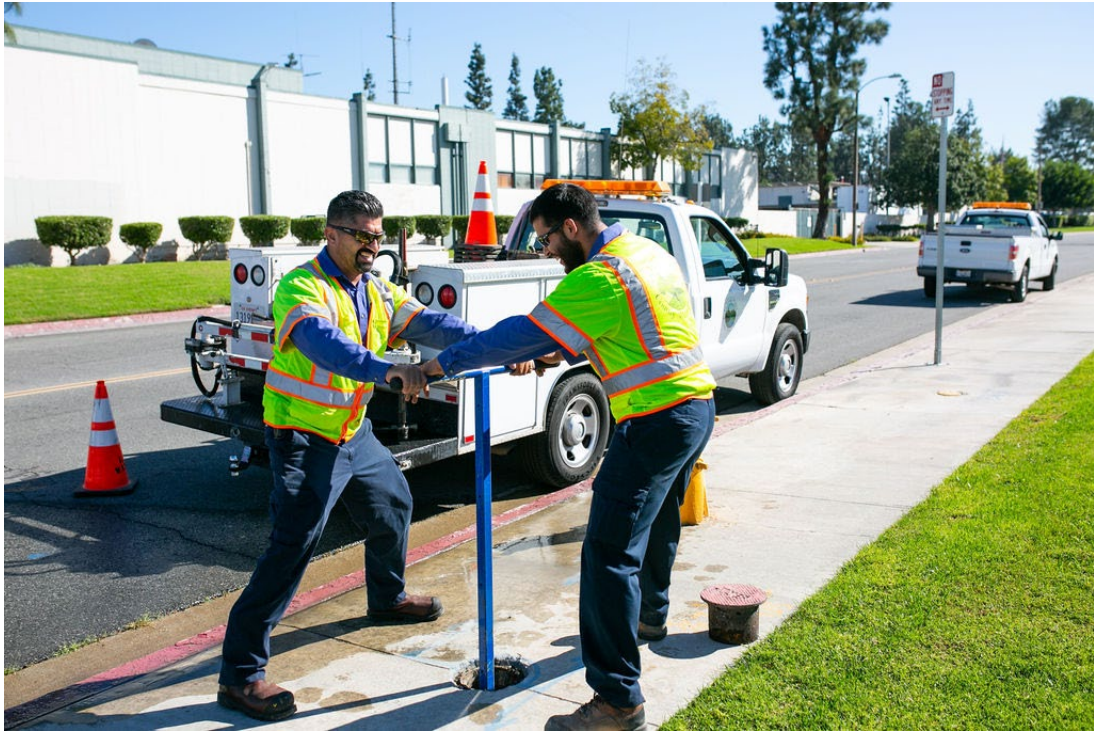
### Nitrate Treatment System –
